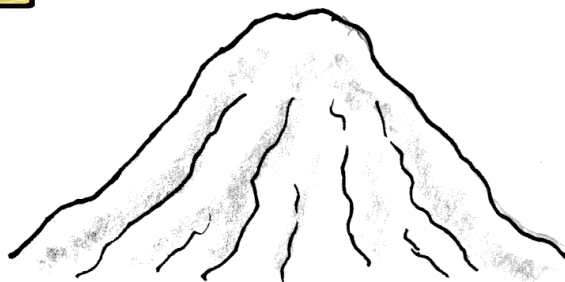

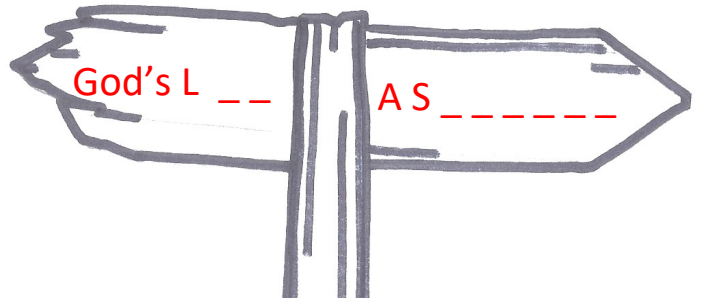
Jesus was not alone; Elijah and Moses appeared with Him. They had both lived hundreds of years before but now they were talking to Jesus.

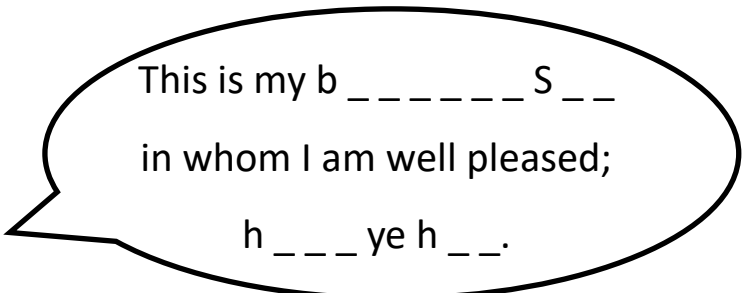
