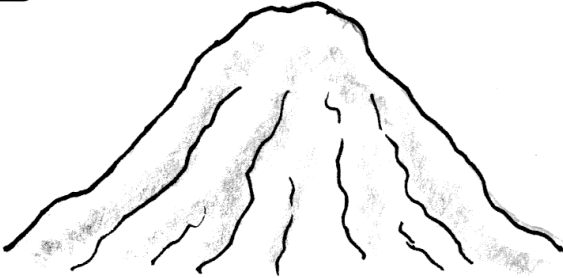

Moses represented God’s law because he was given the ten commandments.

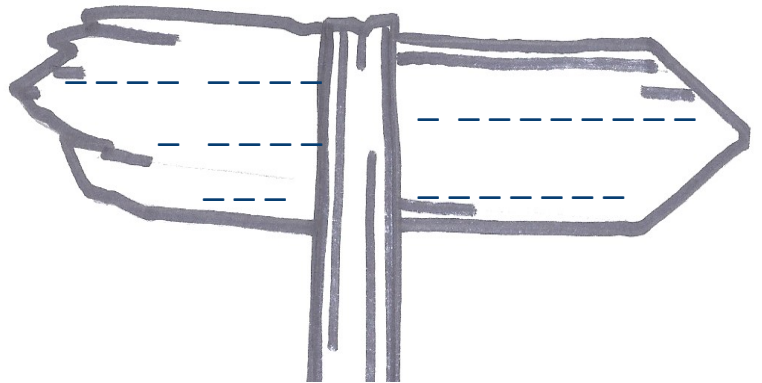

As God’s messenger he pointed back to Moses and forward to Jesus.

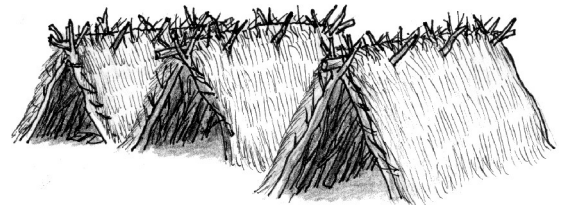
