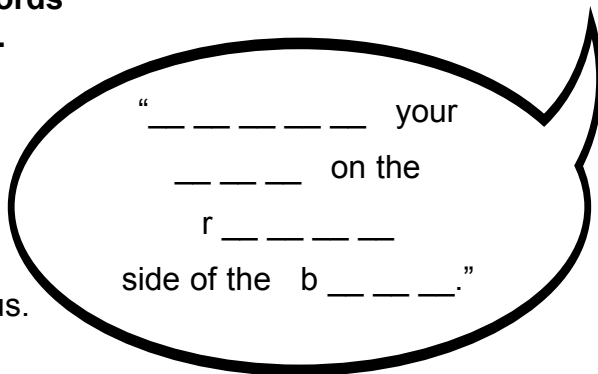

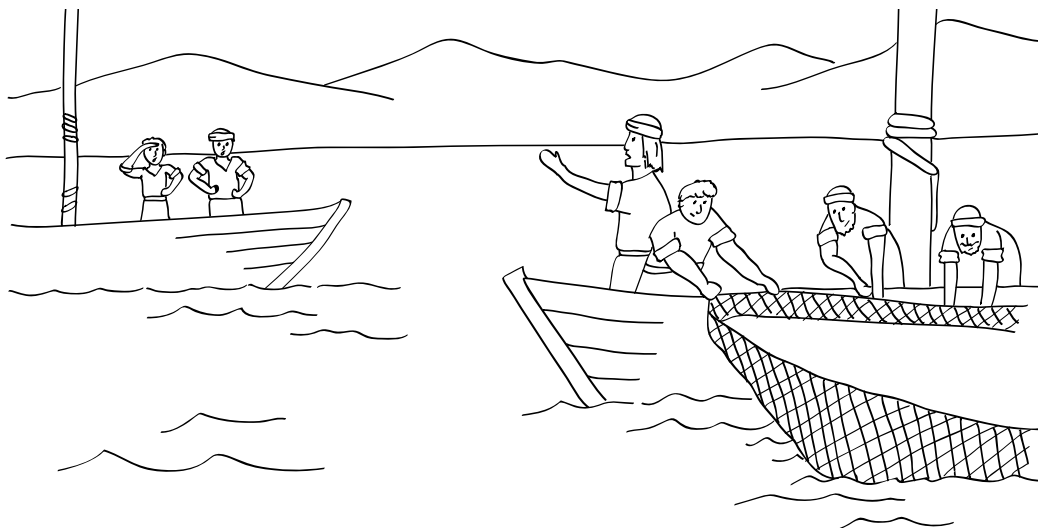
Q: Write in the speech bubble the words that Jesus spoke to the disciples.

Afterwards, the disciples had breakfast with Jesus. He had a fire burning to cook the fish they had caught and He also provided some bread.

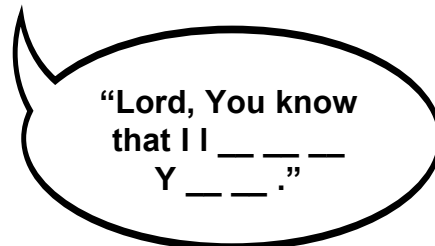
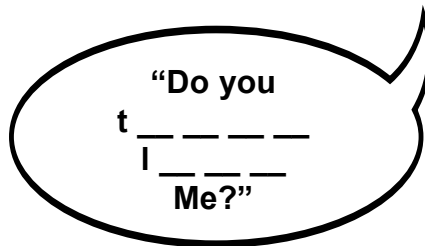
Q: On the menu, tick what they had for breakfast.
