Peter sat nearby warming himself by a fire. A servant girl came up to him and accused him of being with Jesus.

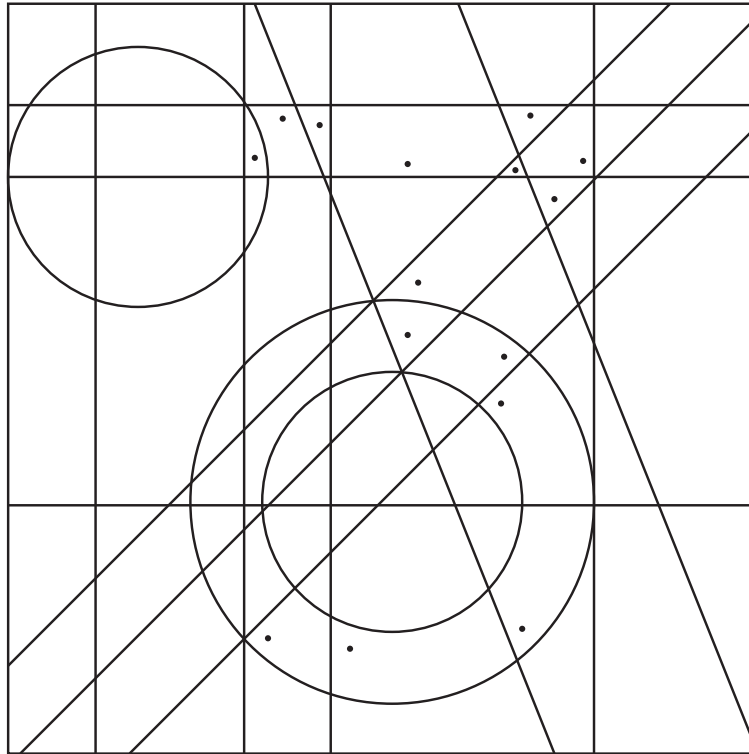
Peter was frightened and told a lie. "I don't know the man," he said.
