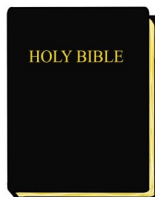

“Follow me”



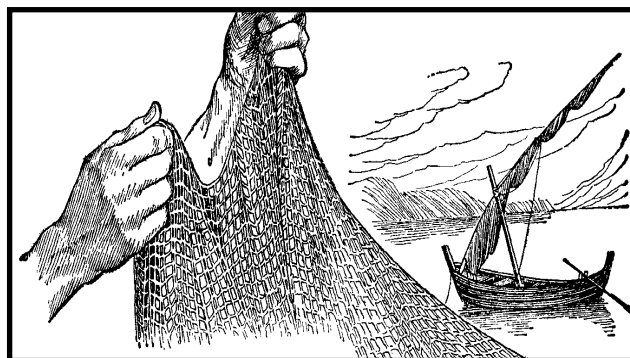
Matthew 4:18-22

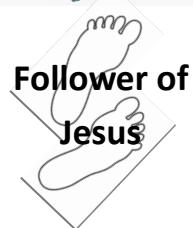

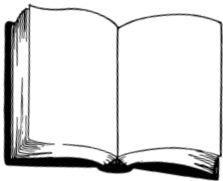
