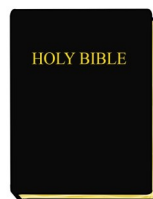

God said that if they did not repent they would be punished. Draw a line to join the words to the matching pictures to show what we have learnt about the enemy that would come.

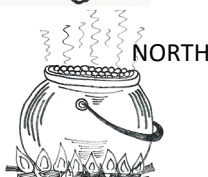
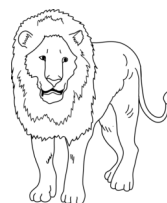

The enemy would destroy Jerusalem like the **bottle** was broken



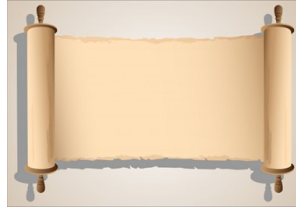
Jeremiah had been stopped from preaching God's message in the temple so God told Jeremiah to write down his message.

What was the message written on? Tick the right box:

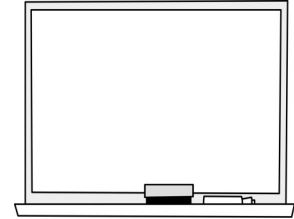
