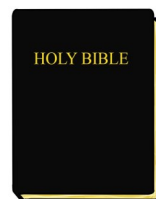

True and False Prophets

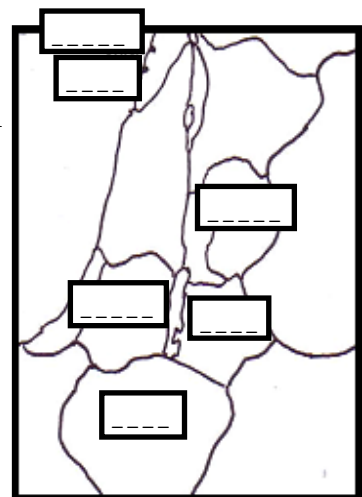
