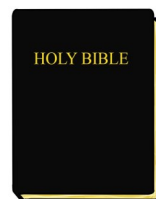

True and False Prophets

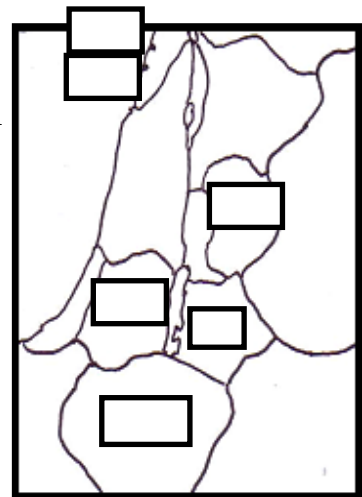


Jeremiah 27
