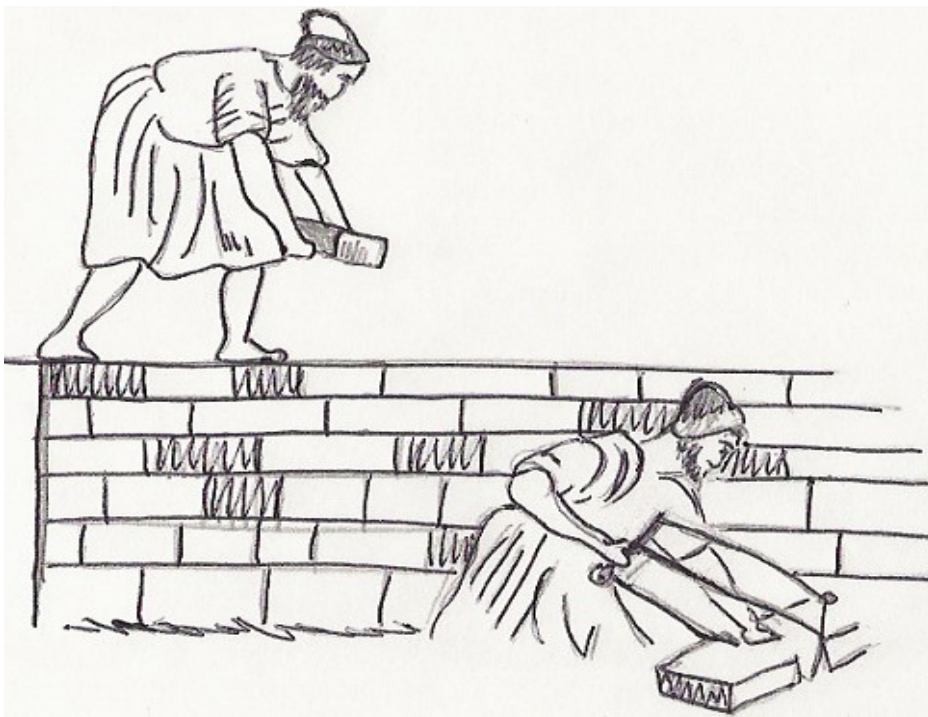


70 years after the beginning of the captivity the people began to come back.
