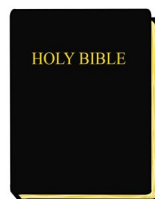

Luke 12 v 16—31

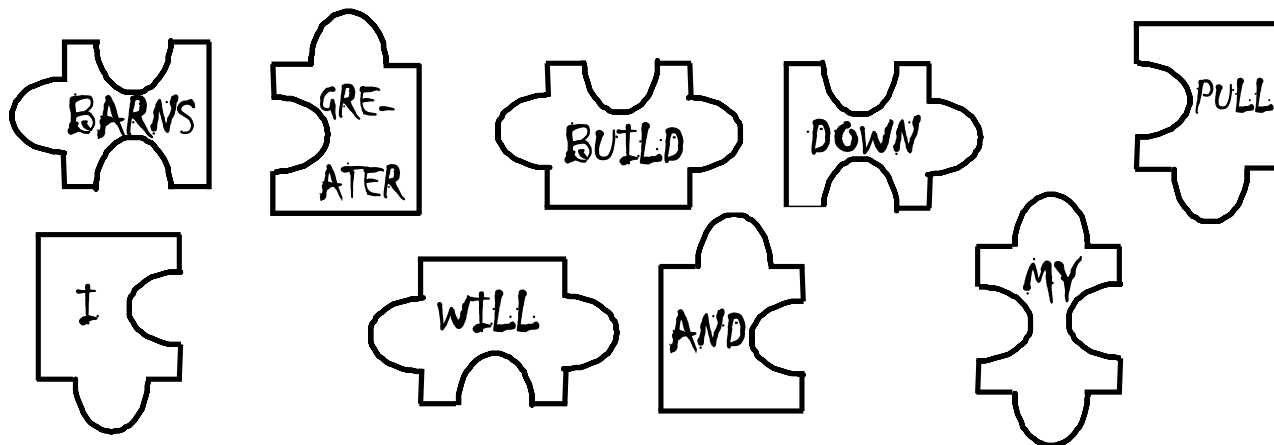
Jesus told a parable about a farmer. A parable is a simple earthly story that teaches us important spiritual lessons.
