


“Make a loaf,” said Elijah, “and give it to me, for God promises you that your flour and your oil won’t be used up until He sends rain again.”

For more than three years there was no rain. One day, God sent Elijah back to King Ahab.


“Come with me to Mount Carmel,” Elijah said to the king. “We will have a test to show who is the true God.”








Who wanted to kill Elijah?

How did Elijah feel?



Circle the correct answer. Where was God?


