Do you remember how the last study began? In the church at Jerusalem there was a group of men who were given a special job to do.

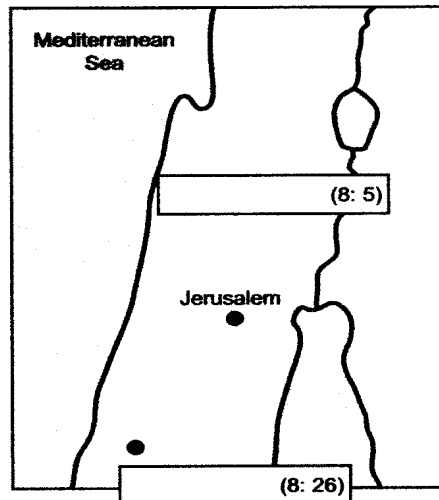
Q: Look back to Acts 6: 5 to find out what that job was, and cross out the incorrect numbers and words in the following sentence:

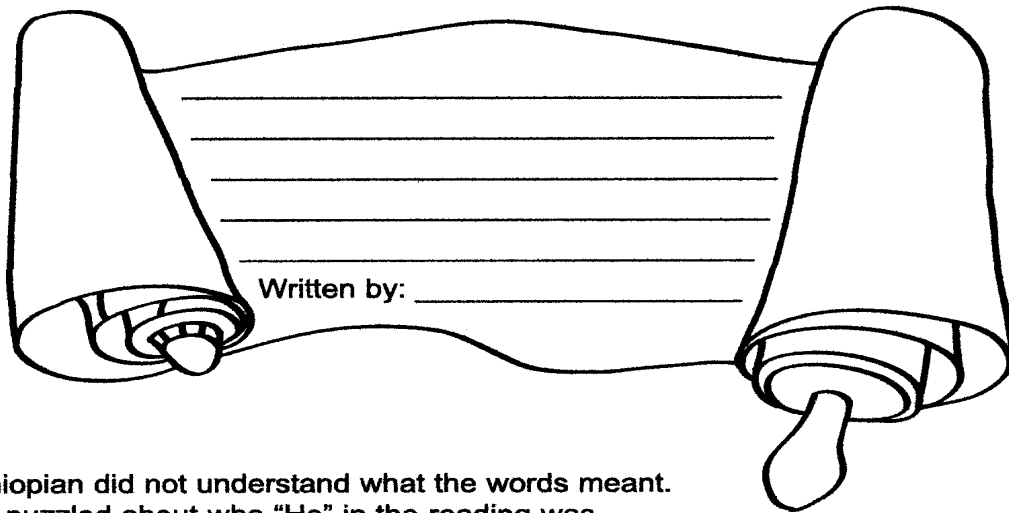
Q: Write on the flag the name of the country, from which the man he met, came.
